

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and Accepting Tohono O'odham Nation Veterans Affairs Office Vehicle
Donation from the Wounded Warrior Family Support Organization)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-181

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,**
3 **education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"**
4 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Native Americans have served in the United States Armed Forces at higher per**
6 **capita rates than any other ethnic group; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Nation's men and women veterans have served in all branches**
8 **of the armed forces in peace time and in combat from World War I to present and**
9 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Veterans Affairs Office was established by**
10 **Resolution No. 99-213 to assist all Nation's Veterans; and**

11 **WHEREAS, due to the limited resources of the Veterans Administration based on the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Nation, Tohono O'odham veterans require transportation to Veterans**
13 **Administration facilities at locations outside the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Veterans Affairs Office requested and received a vehicle donation from the**
15 **Wounded Warrior Family Support Organization, an independent nonprofit**
16 **organization with the mission to provide support to the families of those who**
17 **have been wounded, injured or killed during combat operations; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Veterans Affairs Office is requesting approval and acceptance of the vehicle**
19 **donation from the Wounded Warrior Family Support Organization to assist**
20 **Tohono O'odham veterans with transportation needs; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee has reviewed the Veterans Affairs**
22 **Office vehicle donation from the Wounded Warrior Family Support Organization**
23 **and recommends its approval.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and**
25 **accepts the Tohono O'odham Nation Veterans Affairs Office vehicle donation,**
26 **which will be included in the Veterans Affairs Office fleet, from the Wounded**
27 **Warrior Family Support Organization.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH**
29 **day of JUNE, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
32 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
