

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2018 Hewel Ni'ok KWAK-LP Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-201**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 17-437, the Legislative Council approved the FY 2018 Hewel**  
8 **Ni'ok KWAK-LP Budget in the amount of \$227,541.99 as a part of the Executive**  
9 **Branch budget; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Hewel Ni'ok has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2018**  
11 **Hewel Ni'ok KWAK-LP Budget Amendment No. 1 in the amount of \$227,541.99,**  
12 **which is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and/or**  
13 **personnel line items but does not change the original budget amount; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation and the Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed**  
15 **the FY 2018 Hewel Ni'ok KWAK-LP Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its**  
16 **approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
18 **FY 2018 Hewel Ni'ok KWAK-LP Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2017**  
19 **in the amount of \$227,541.99, which does not change the original budget amount.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
21 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
22 **expend the FY 2018 Hewel Ni'ok KWAK-LP Budget as amended, provided that any**  
23 **amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**  
24 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>**  
26 **day of JUNE, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**  
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
