

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2018 Department of Education Special Services Program Individuals
with Disabilities Education Act Part C Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-212

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2018 Department of Education Special Services Program Individuals with
8 Disabilities Education Act ("IDEA") Part C Budget in the amount of \$76,275.95 was
9 approved by Resolution No. 17-438; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Education Special Services Program has prepared and
11 submitted for review and approval its FY 2018 IDEA Part C Budget Amendment No.
12 1, which is incorporated by this reference and which will adjust operational and
13 capital line items, and create new line items; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2018 Department of Education Special Services Program IDEA Part C
15 Budget Amendment No. 1 will increase the overall budgeted amount by
16 \$82,258.23 from \$76,275.95 to \$158,534.18; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
18 reviewed the FY 2018 Department of Education Special Services Program IDEA
19 Part C Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21 FY 2018 Department of Education Special Services Program IDEA Part C Budget
22 Amendment No. 1 which includes an increase of \$82,258.23 from \$76,275.95 to
23 \$158,534.18 that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending
24 reimbursement from the grantor.

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
26 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
27 expend the FY 2018 Department of Education Special Services Program IDEA Part
28 C Budget as amended, provided however, that any amendments or modifications
29 shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

30 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH**
31 **day of JUNE, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,853.5 FOR; -0-**
32 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 231.1 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
33 **by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
34 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
35 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
36 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
