

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association to Submit an Application to the
Department of Housing and Urban Development for the 2018 Healthy Homes Production
Grant Program for Tribal Housing for Mold Remediation and Prevention)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-229

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,**
3 **morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its**
4 **members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") is the Nation's tribally**
6 **designated housing entity in accordance with the Native American Housing**
7 **Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. § 4101, et seq., P.L. 104-**
8 **330, 110 Stat. 4106 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the**
9 **Indian Housing Block Grant ("IHBG") and to seek other funds to operate,**
10 **maintain, and expand affordable housing; and**

11 **WHEREAS, TOKA is a "tribal organization" that has been determined eligible to apply directly**
12 **for HUD Healthy Homes funds by the HUD Southwest Office of Native American**
13 **Programs, provided that the Tohono O'odham Nation authorizes it to do so on its**
14 **behalf (24 C.F.R. § 1003.5); and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Nation and the TOKA recognize the dire need for mold remediation and**
16 **prevention in many of the previously HUD financed low-income housing units as**
17 **confirmed in studies conducted in 2006 by a HUD financed assessment and by the**
18 **Indian Health Services; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the TOKA will address the unhealthy conditions of existing units by submitting a**
20 **2018 Healthy Homes Production Grant Program for Tribal Housing for mold**
21 **remediation and prevention application for \$1,000,000.00, which commits to**
22 **leverage funds to substantially rehabilitate single-family low-income HUD**
23 **financed housing units; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the HUD Healthy Homes regulations at 24 CFR 1003.5 and the Healthy Homes**
25 **notice of funding availability require a tribal organization that submits an**
26 **application on behalf of an eligible tribe to first obtain authorization for**
27 **submission by resolution from the tribe.**

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that TOKA is**
29 **authorized to submit the 2018 Healthy Homes Production Grant Program for**
30 **Tribal Housing for mold remediation and prevention funding in the amount of**
31 **\$1,000,000 to substantially rehabilitate low-income HUD financed housing units.**

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
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BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it agrees to commit IHBG leveraging funds through the Nation's Indian Housing Plan, if TOKA's grant application is approved by HUD.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH day of JULY, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,853.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 231.1[01] NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


