4		including proceeds derived from lands and resources of the Tohono O'odham
5		Nation and to appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its
6		members" provided that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to
7		appropriations or budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution,
8		Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and
9	WHEREAS,	the U.S. Department of the Interior, Office of the Special Trustee reported
10		available funds for distribution in the amount of \$68,864.32 as of March 31, 2018,
11		in the Schuk Toak District's Proceeds of Labor account ending in 8705, which is
12		held at the U.S. Department of the Interior, Office of the Special Trustee; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Schuk Toak District has been notified of the availability of these funds; and
14	WHEREAS,	on April 20, 2018, the Tohono O'odham Nation's treasurer presented to the
15		Tohono O'odham Nation Investment Committee regarding the available funds,
16		and the Investment Committee supports the drawing down of these funds; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation's treasurer recommends that these funds be
18		deposited into the Tohono O'odham Nation's Bank of America General Checking
19		Account until the Schuk Toak District submits a budget for subsequent
20		expenditure.
21	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it
22		authorizes the U.S. Department of the Interior, Office of the Special Trustee to
23		distribute the Schuk Toak District's funds in the amount of \$68,864.32 from the
24		Proceeds of Labor account ending in 8705, which is held at the U.S. Department of
25		the Interior, Office of the Special Trustee.
26	BE IT FINALI	Y RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the release
27		of the applicable wire instructions for the Tohono O'odham Nation's Bank of
28		America General Checking Account to the U.S. Department of the Interior, Office
29		of the Special Trustee to facilitate the distribution of the funds.
