

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association to Submit a Renewal Application
to the Department of Housing and Urban Development and Department of
Veterans Affairs for the Tribal HUD-VASH Supportive Housing Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-261

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,**
3 **morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its**
4 **members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") is the Nation's tribally**
6 **designated housing entity in accordance with the Native American Housing**
7 **Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. § 4101, et seq., P.L. 104-**
8 **330, 110 Stat. 4106 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the**
9 **Indian Housing Block Grant and to seek other funds to operate maintain and**
10 **expand affordable housing; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council and the TOKA recognize the dire need to continue to**
12 **support rental and long term housing opportunities for our Nation's veterans;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, the TOKA has developed an application for the Tribal Housing and Urban**
15 **Development-Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing ("HUD-VASH") program to**
16 **provide rental assistance for the most vulnerable tribal veterans; and**

17 **WHEREAS, assistance will be in the form of short term rental housing assistance for tribal**
18 **veterans in immediate need of services who may be homeless or residing in**
19 **unsafe, overcrowded situations; and**

20 **WHEREAS, if the renewal grant application is successful, grant funds will be used to provide**
21 **rental housing assistance for qualified tribal veterans; and**

22 **WHEREAS, TOKA, in collaboration with the Veteran Affairs Office, will work to publicize the**
23 **program to identify qualified tribal veterans to participate in the program; and**

24 **WHEREAS, TOKA has been successfully implementing the VASH program since 2016, serving**
25 **more than 27 tribal members who have applied for assistance; and**

26 **WHEREAS, great need still exists to provide housing services to underserved tribal veterans;**
27 **and**

28 **WHEREAS, the Housing Committee has reviewed the TOKA's renewal application and**
29 **recommends approval.**

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the TOKA to**
6 **execute all documents necessary to submit TOKA's renewal application and**
7 **implement the TOKA's HUD-VASH program.**


8 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST**

12 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
13 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
14 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
