

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2019 Water Resources Department Environmental Protection Agency Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-300

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Water Resources Department has prepared and submitted for review and
8 approval its FY 2019 Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") Budget, which is
9 incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$135,000.00 to be funded by the
10 Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the EPA; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
12 2019 Water Resources Department EPA Budget and recommend its approval.


13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
14 FY 2019 Water Resources Department EPA Budget effective October 1, 2018 in the
15 amount of \$135,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund
16 pending reimbursement from the grantor, the EPA.

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
18 Nation's chairperson or his designee to seek reimbursement for indirect cost
19 expenses in the event an indirect cost rate is approved.

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
22 expend the FY 2019 Water Resources Department EPA Budget, provided that any
23 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
24 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH
26 day of AUGUST, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-
27 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
28 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by
29 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
30 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
31 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
