

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2019 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights
Office Administration Budget TERO Commission Revenue Funding)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-322

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
8 approval its FY 2019 Tribal Employment Rights Office ("TERO") Administration
9 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$598,762.99, of
10 which \$335,354.66 is to be funded by the Nation's general fund, and \$263,408.33 is
11 to be funded from TERO Commission revenue funding; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the portion of the FY 2019 Department of Public Safety TERO Administration
13 Budget funded by the Nation's general fund is addressed by separate resolution;
14 and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
16 reviewed the FY 2019 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights
17 Office Administration Budget TERO Commission revenue funding and
18 recommend its approval.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
20 FY 2019 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office
21 Administration Budget TERO Commission revenue funding effective October 1,
22 2018 in the amount of \$263,408.33.

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
24 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
25 expend the FY 2019 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office
26 Administration Budget TERO Commission revenue funding, provided that any
27 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
28 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH**
30 **day of AUGUST, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
32 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
33 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
34 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
35 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**

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
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


