

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2019 Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights
Office Equal Employment Opportunity Commission Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-331

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety Tribal Employment Rights Office ("TERO") has
8 prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2019 Department of
9 Public Safety TERO Equal Employment Opportunity Commission ("EEOC")
10 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$26,000.00 to be
11 funded from the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the Equal
12 Employment Opportunity Commission; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees
14 have reviewed the FY 2019 Department of Public Safety TERO EEOC Budget and
15 recommend its approval.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
17 FY 2019 Department of Public Safety TERO EEOC Budget effective October 1, 2018
18 in the amount of \$26,000.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund
19 pending reimbursement by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
21 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
22 expend the FY 2019 Department of Public Safety TERO EEOC Budget, provided that
23 any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
24 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH**
26 **day of AUGUST, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
