

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2019 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice,
Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-345

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
8 **approval its FY 2019 U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing**
9 **Services ("COPS") Hiring Program Grant Budget, which is incorporated by this**
10 **reference, in the amount of \$48,447.00 to be funded by the U.S. Department of**
11 **Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant and the FY**
12 **2019 Department of Public Safety Police Department Law Enforcement Budget;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
15 **2019 Department of Public Safety U.S. Department of Justice, Community**
16 **Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant Budget and recommend its**
17 **approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
19 **FY 2019 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice, Community**
20 **Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Budget effective September 1, 2018 in**
21 **the amount of \$48,447.00, which shall be funded by the U.S. Department of Justice,**
22 **Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Grant and the FY 2019**
23 **Department of Public Safety Police Department Law Enforcement Budget.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
26 **expend the FY 2019 Department of Public Safety, U.S. Department of Justice,**
27 **Community Oriented Policing Services Hiring Program Budget, provided that**
28 **any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the**
29 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

30 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND**
31 **day of AUGUST, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR; -0-**
32 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
33 **Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
34 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
35 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
36 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
