

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Nominating Charlene Aguilla to Serve on the Census Bureau National Advisory
Committee on Racial, Ethnic, and Other Populations)**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-372

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2 the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3 education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members. .
4 ." and to "consult with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal
5 agencies regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation . . ."
6 (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the National Advisory Committee ("NAC") on Racial, Ethnic, and Other
8 Populations was established by the Census Bureau in accordance with the
9 Federal Advisory Committee Act ("FACA"), and consists of up to 32 members who
10 serve for a three-year term at the discretion of the Director of the Census Bureau
11 ("Director"); and

12 **WHEREAS,** the NAC advises the Census Bureau on the identification of new strategies for
13 improved census operations, and survey and data collection methods, including
14 identifying cost efficient ways to increase response rates; and

15 **WHEREAS,** in providing insight, perspectives, and expertise on the full spectrum of Census
16 Bureau surveys and programs, the Committee examines such areas as hidden
17 households, language barriers, students and youth, aging populations, American
18 Indian and Alaska Native tribal considerations, new immigrant populations,
19 populations affected by natural disasters, highly mobile and migrant
20 populations, complex households, poverty, race/ethnic distribution, privacy and
21 confidentiality, rural populations and businesses, individuals and households
22 with limited access to information and communications technologies, the
23 dynamic nature of new businesses, minority ownership of businesses, as well as
24 other concerns impacting Census Bureau survey design and implementation;
25 and

26 **WHEREAS,** by a June 4, 2018 Federal Register Notice, the Census Bureau is requesting
27 nominations of members to serve on the National Advisory Committee on Racial,
28 Ethnic, and Other Populations; and

29 **WHEREAS,** based upon the importance of the census for federal representation and funding
30 and the persistent undercount of tribal members, it is in the Nation's best
31 interests to nominate Charlene Aguilla from the Nation's Planning and Economic
32 Development Department to the National Advisory Committee on Racial, Ethnic,
33 and Other Populations; and

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
1 **WHEREAS, the Housing and Rules Committees recommend nominating Charlene Aguilla to**
2 **serve on the National Advisory Committee on Racial, Ethnic, and Other**
3 **Populations.**

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council nominates**
5 **Charlene Aguilla to the National Advisory Committee on Racial, Ethnic, and Other**
6 **Populations.**

7 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that an appointment**
8 **made pursuant to this resolution shall immediately expire if the appointee in this**
9 **resolution no longer serves as an employee of the Nation.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH**
11 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR;**
12 **-0- AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
13 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and 1(j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
14 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
15 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
16 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**



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
