

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Accepting Six Month No Cost Extension of the U.S. Department of Justice Community  
Oriented Policing Services Technology Program Award No. 2010CKWX0333 and  
Approving FY 2019 Department of Public Safety U.S. Department of Justice  
Community Oriented Policing Services Technology Program Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-400**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department was**  
8 **awarded the U.S. Department of Justice ("DOJ") Community Oriented Policing**  
9 **Service ("COPS") Technology Program, Award No. 2010CKWX0333 in the amount**  
10 **of \$100,000.00, which was accepted by Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
11 **Resolution No. 11-096; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety, Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department**  
13 **requested and was approved for a six month no cost extension from the DOJ COPS**  
14 **for Award No. 2010CKWX0333 for the period of June 16, 2018 through December**  
15 **15, 2018; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the grant does not allow for indirect costs; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**  
18 **approval its FY 2019 Department of Public Safety DOJ COPS Technology Program**  
19 **Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$100,000.00 to**  
20 **be funded from the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the**  
21 **grantor; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the**  
23 **Department of Public Safety DOJ COPS Technology Program, Award No.**  
24 **2010CKWX0333 six month no cost extension and the FY 2019 Department of Public**  
25 **Safety DOJ COPS Technology Program Budget and recommends its approval.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the**  
27 **six month no cost extension for the DOJ COPS Technology Program, Award No.**  
28 **2010CKWX0333 for the grant period of June 16, 2018 through December 15, 2018.**

29 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2019**  
30 **Department of Public Safety DOJ COPS Technology Program Budget in the**  
31 **amount of \$100,000.00 effective June 16, 2018 through December 15, 2018, which**  
32 **shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the**  
33 **grantor.**

2 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and  
3 expend the FY 2019 Department of Public Safety DOJ COPS Technology Program  
4 Budget provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for  
5 prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26<sup>TH</sup>  
7 day of SEPTEMBER, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084,6 FOR;  
8 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
9 Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by  
10 the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
11 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
12 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


