

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2019 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 18-461

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2018 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget in the amount of**
8 **\$1,946,668.23 was approved by Resolution No. 18-301; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department is requesting to change the justification in the**
10 **7355 Professional Services to include aerial survey data collection; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department is also requesting to move \$198,000.00 from**
12 **7800 Water Permit & Storage Expense to 7355 Professional Services to cover**
13 **additional services; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
15 **2019 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget Amendment No. 1 and**
16 **recommend its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **FY 2019 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget Amendment No. 1 to:**

- 19 **1. change the justification in the 7355 Professional Services to include aerial**
20 **survey data collection and**
- 21 **2. move \$198,000 from 7800 Water Permit & Storage Expense to 7355**
22 **Professional Services to cover additional services. The approved FY19**
23 **SAWRSA budget of \$1,946,668.23 will remain the same.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
26 **expend the FY 2019 Water Resources Department SAWRSA Budget as amended,**
27 **provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior**
28 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD**
30 **day of DECEMBER, 2018 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,084.6 FOR;**
31 **~~0~~ AGAINST; ~~0~~ NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
32 **Article VI, Section 1 (d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
33 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
34 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
35 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
