RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL



No. 138

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of Three hundred and sixty (\$360.00) Dollars from the fund, "I. I. H. Acct. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe." for payment of the salary of the caretaker of the New Papago Tribal Community House.

FROVIDED that this appropriation shall be set up in an I.I.M. Account and shall be paid by the Superintendent of Sells Agency upon the written request of the Secretary of the Papago Council each month.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 25, 1941 duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
