RESCLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency or other officer in charge, to allow the Secretary of the Papago Council to expend funds provided for by Resolution No. 119 of the Papago Council enacted under date of July 6, 1950, for the purchase of an electric organ to be installed in the auditorium of the New Papago Tribal Community House.

The foregoing resolution was on January 25, 1941 duly er cted by a vote of 20 for, and 0 against, by the Tapago Council, pursuar to authority vested in it by Section 3, (a), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1935, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1938 (48 Stat). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of bells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and B -laws of the Tapago Tribe.
