

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL


Number 142

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize Chairman Peter Blaine to execute the "Grant Agreement for Relief and Rehabilitation Grant to Organized Tribe" in behalf of the Papago Tribe, the said agreement to cover a grant of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars from the United States Government to the Papago Tribe for use in connection with the eradication of Dourine among the horses on the Sells jurisdiction.


The foregoing resolution was on March 8, 1941, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2, (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on Dec. 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jan. 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
