

RESOLUTION OF

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL.

No. 143

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby confirm and approve the appointment of the following men:

Espirito Adams
Manuel Puella
John Ortiz

by the Chairman of the Papago Council to be a committee to work out rules and regulations for the proper cooperation of the Papago Tribe in the testing of all horses on the Papago Reservation for Bouring; and,

PROVIDED FURTHER that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency or other officer in charge to reimburse the members of this Committee for travel expense incurred in attending the meetings of the Committee at Sells, Arizona at the same rate as is required for attending the regular meetings of the Papago Council, from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe"

The foregoing Resolution was on March 19, 1941, duly enacted by a vote of 11 for and 1 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1930, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe.
