

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 147

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency, or other officer in charge, to reimburse the members of the various committees which may be appointed by the Papago Tribal Council for travel expenses which may be incurred in coming to attend the meetings in connections with the duties assigned them by the Council, at the same rate of pay as is received for attending the regular meetings of the Papago Council, from the fund, "I. I. H. Acct. No. P-84, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe."

The foregoing Resolution was on April 16, 1941, duly enacted by a vote of 21 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
