RESCLVED FURTHER that the Gorretary-Treasurer of the Tapago Council in addition to performing the combined duties of Georetary-Treasurer of the Papago Council as prescribed by Sections 3 and 4 of Article 1 of the By-laws of the Papago Tribe, shall also perform the duties of Clerk of the Sells Court of Indian Offenses and Clerk of the Papago Loan Board; and

RESOLVED FURTHER that we hereby respectfully request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to allot the sum of \$ 2,028,00 from the fund, "Trocoeds of Papago Indian Reservation, Arizona., Rontals, etc., (Tribal Councils, 1942)" to the Superintendent of Sells Agency as soon after July 1, 1941 as may be practicable; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we hereby authorize and request the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, or other officer in charge, to pay to the order of the Secretary-Treasurer of the Papago Council, the sum of \$ 2,200.00 from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-Uh, Contributed Fund, Fapago Tribe", and \$ 416.00 from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-h, Papago Loan Fund" for deposit under the same conditions as those of the provious fiscal year.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 14, 1941 duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papage Council, pursuant to sutherity vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution of the Papage Tribe.
