RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize the Pima County to remove sand, gravel, and other earthy materials necessary in the construction of the Tucson-Alt highway project U. S. 110-1-1941., as explained in Resolution No. 151 of the Papago Council, enacted under date of June 14, 1941.; and

RESOLVED FURTHER that permits be issued to Pima County in accordance with the above provisions.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 14, 1941 duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (c), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its resolution by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
