RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize the Chairman of the Papago Council to renew the permit covering the airplane hangar site occupied by N. A. O'Mara for one year commencing July 1, 1941 and ending June 30, 1942; and

RESOLVED FURTHER that this resolution shall be retroactive so that it may cover collection of ground rental for one year period beginning July 1, 1940 to June 30, 1941 for which time a resolution was not enacted; and

PROVIDED that the above shall be executed for a consideration of \$24.00 per year, said sum to be deposited to the credit of the Papago General Fund, Individual Indian Money Account No. F-3, at the Sells Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 14, 1941 duly enacted by a vote of 13 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, purusuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Sells Agency.
