RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 158

RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated the sume of Two Hundred (\$200.30) Dollars from the fund, "I. I. H. Acct. Do. P-64, Contributed Fund, Lapago Tribe" to be used for the installation of a cooling system in the Lapago Tribal Community Auditorium and for the reinforcing of the windows in the building, and for such other minor repairs to the building as may be necessary.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 6, 1941 duly enacted by a vote of ______ for, and _____ against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (46 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Bella Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the rapago Tribe.
