## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Day No. 152

RESOLVED by the Papago Council that we hereby approve and authorize the selling of bat guano which is at present stored for the tribe at San Kavier reservation.

RESOLVED FURTHER that we authorize the Chairman of the Papago Council to supervise the selling and freighting of this guano to the firm offering the best price and that selling of this guano shall be left in his hands.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1941 duly enacted by a vote of // for, and // against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority visted in it by Section 3(h) and 3(k), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective is of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
