

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 101

Resolved by the Papago Council that we hereby authorize and approve the use of the balance of the Papago Council Budget for the fiscal year, 1941 for the operation of the business of the Papago Council until the budget for the fiscal year 1942 shall have been set up.

Provided that this fund shall be used for the payment of travel expenses for the delegates to the Council in attending meetings and for the payment of those other expenses which are usually paid by the Papago Council in the operation of its business; and

PROVIDED FURTHER That when the budget for the fiscal year 1942 shall be set up an amount shall be replaced sufficient to pay the salary of the Caretaker of the Papago Tribal Community House for the fiscal year 1942 at the rate of \$60.00 per month.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 6, 1941 duly enacted by a vote of 15 for, and _____, against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 11, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
