

RESOLUTION OF  
THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

... and by the Papago Tribal Council that we hereby approve and confirm  
the selection of the following men by the Chairman of the Papago Council to  
form a Board to take care of the Tribal Head:

John Ortiz  
Manuel Fuelle  
Jones Marcho, Jr.,  
Peter Blaine

BE IT VIVID, that this Board shall formulate ordinances which shall be  
submitted to the Papago Council for approval; that this Board shall be per-  
manent and its members shall not be removed without cause or as long as the  
Board functions efficiently; that vacancies created shall be filled as pro-  
vided in the approved ordinances of the Board.

IT IS FURTHER that the members of this Board shall be reimbursed  
for travel expenses in accordance with Resolution 147 of the Papago Tribal  
Council.

The foregoing resolution was on September 24, 1941, duly enacted by a  
vote of 17 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority  
vested in it by Section 2(e), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe,  
ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of  
the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13,  
(48 Stat. 124). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval  
by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the  
Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the  
Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
