

RESOLUTION OF
THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

No. 168

RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that we appropriate and there is hereby appropriated the sum of 20.00 from the fund, "I. I. M. Acct. No. P-34, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe" to an account entitled "I. I. M. Account No. T-27". This sum of money is to be used as a budget for the operation of the Tribal Herd until July 1, 1942.

PROVIDED that this appropriation shall be used to meet expenses as they are outlined in a memorandum to the Chairman of the Papago Tribal Council from Mr. Ralph M. Gelvin, Agriculture Extension Agent, dated September 24, 1941.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 24, 1941, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V. of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Galls Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
