WHEREAS in the present time of national emergency it is clearly seen that the duty of every good American citizen is to sacrifice to the utmost to aid the United States of America; and

WHERMAS it is the desire of the Papago Tribe of Arizona to take a very active part in assuming the responsibilities of good citizenship;

THEREFORE be it resolved by the Papago Tribal Council that we appropriate, and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$ 7,500.00 (Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars) from the fund, "I. I. E. Acct. No. P-24, Contributed Fund, Papago Tribe" to be used in the buying of Defense Bonds in the name, of the Papago Tribe; and

RESCLVED FURTHER that we authorize and request the Superintendent of Sells Agency to supervise this transaction for us.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 6, 1941, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for, and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V, of the Constitution of the tribe ratified by the tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, subject to its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V. of the Constitution and By-laws of the Fapago Tribe.
