

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting an Economic Development Plan for the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-013

1 **WHEREAS, the Economic Development Task Force and staff met with Districts and**
2 **communities over the past six months, with the goal of preparing a Draft Economic**
3 **Development Plan; and**

4 **WHEREAS, at these meetings the people spoke out, voicing their concerns and making**
5 **recommendations regarding Economic Development; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Task Force prepared a draft Economic Development Plan based on the**
7 **Community's desires and goals and presented it back to the People for comment;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, members of the Tohono O'odham Nation expressed their support of the Plan; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the majority of the Districts have supported the Draft Economic Development Plan**
11 **by resolutions and recommended that it be adopted as the Economic Development**
12 **Plan for the Nation; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Task Force and staff have met with the District Chairpersons' Association,**
14 **Commerce Committee and the Chairman of the Nation and they have**
15 **recommended that the Plan be reviewed by Council; and**

16 **WHEREAS, on Tuesday, January 04, 2000, during the regular Legislative Council session, the**
17 **Task Force did present the Final Draft of the Economic Development Plan along**
18 **with the District Resolutions recommending the adoption of the Plan.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council did review the proposed Plan**
20 **and adopts it as the Economic Development Plan for the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Economic Development Task Force will develop plans of**
22 **organization and operations, and submit timelines on implementation for each**
23 **component described in the Plan.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that once the plans of organization and operation are developed,**
25 **that they will be presented to the Districts for review and comment, then to the**
26 **Legislative Council for adoption.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Task Force will develop financial plans for each**
28 **organization described in the Economic Development Plan and present them to**
29 **the Districts for review and comment, then to the Legislative Council for adoption.**

4 Section 1 (c)(2) & (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by
5 the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
7 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
