

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Acceptance of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX Assistance  
/Amendment to extend the original project and budget periods for the Tohono  
O'odham Nation Voluntary Clean-up Program grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-016**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation signed a Cooperative Agreement with the United**  
2 **States Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX to develop a Voluntary Clean-**  
3 **up Program; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the original project and budget periods were October 1, 1998 to September 30,**  
5 **1999; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the EPA, Region IX granted an extension for budget and project periods of October**  
7 **1, 1996 to September 30, 2000 with EPA Assistance Amendment #4.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
9 **approves the Voluntary Clean-up Program extension.**

10 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
11 **O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any**  
12 **designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**  
13 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of**  
14 **the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH.**  
16 **day of JANUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,833.7 FOR;**  
17 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 331.8 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
18 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**  
19 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
20 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
21 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


