(Funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council to attend the NCAI  
Youth Commission annually)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-020**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
2 **Youth Council as the official voice for youth of the Tohono O'odham Nation per**  
3 **Resolution No. 95-216; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has funded, in full, to send youth of our**  
5 **nation to represent and attend the National Congress of American Indians in Palm**  
6 **Springs, CA held on October 3-8, 1999; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council were the youth who where funded by**  
8 **the Legislative Council; and**


9 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council encourages a continual development of young Tohono**  
10 **O'odham leaders by exposing them to leadership opportunities such as the NCAI**  
11 **Youth Commission.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**  
13 **Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council to attend the NCAI Youth Commission**  
14 **annually by allocating fund annually for a youth delegation to attend from the**  
15 **Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the source of funding to support attendance of the youth**  
17 **delegation to NCAI will be identified in the FY 2001 budgets.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH,**  
19 **day of JANUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,958.35 FOR;**  
20 **-0- AGAINST; 207.15 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
21 **by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**  
22 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**  
24 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


