

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Continuation of Hickiwan District Home Renovation Project)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-021

1 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District, at a Special Meeting on January 04, 2000 met to discuss the
2 District's Home Renovation Project; and

3 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District sees a need for the continued use of the \$500,000.00 for the
4 Home Renovation Project; and

5 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District has sufficient funds in First Union Securities account to
6 cover costs on the Home Renovation Project.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and
8 supports the need for the continued use of the Home Renovation Project funds
9 through March 2000.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that Hickiwan District
11 does have sufficient funds to cover the costs of the Home Renovation Project.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH
14 day of JANUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,879.0 FOR;
15 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 286.5 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the
16 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
17 adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
18 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
19 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


