

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting and Accepting the Soil Survey of the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-039**

1 **WHEREAS, the soil resources of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Arizona are an integral part of**  
2 **the natural resource base of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resource Conservation Service (Formerly The Soil Conservation**  
4 **Service) has leadership for the federal part of the Nation Cooperative Soil Survey;**  
5 **and**

6 **WHEREAS, a soil survey was made cooperatively by the Tohono O'odham Nation, the Natural**  
7 **Resources Conservation Service, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Arizona**  
8 **Agricultural Experiment Station and the Tohono O'odham Soil and Water**  
9 **Conservation District; and**

10 **WHEREAS, completed soil survey can be used by planners, tribal officials, engineers, farmers,**  
11 **ranchers and others who can use the information to guide land use decisions; and**

12 **WHEREAS, conservationists, teachers, students and other specialists can use the survey to**  
13 **help them understand, protect and enhance the environment; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Agriculture Committee supports the acceptance of the**  
15 **completed Soil Survey.**


16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports and accepts the**  
17 **SOIL SURVEY OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION (Parts of Maricopa, Pima and**  
18 **Pinal Counties).**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation will work with the Natural**  
20 **Resources Conservation Service and the Tohono O'odham Soil and Water**  
21 **Conservation District to assure that the Soil Survey of the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
22 **is distributed across the Nation and that users are familiar with how to utilize the**  
23 **information it contains.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH,**  
25 **day of FEBRUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,086.45 FOR;**  
26 **-0- AGAINST; 79.05 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
27 **by Section 1 (1) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**  
30 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


