

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 2000 Department of Human Services/Division of Community Health
Services - Elder Health Care Initiative Budget Modification #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-041

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently developing a Home Health Agency under**
2 **IHS Grant #ISH002103-02 with the Indian Health Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 99-440, approved a five year project**
4 **and year three budget in the amount of \$196,743.00; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Grants and Contracts Office has notified the**
6 **Community Health Services/Elder Initiative of \$114,594.35 of carry over funds**
7 **available for use this fiscal year; and**

8 **WHEREAS, there is a continued need for coordinated, comprehensive delivery of basic Home**
9 **Health Care to frail and disabled elders in their home on the Tohono O'odham**
10 **Nation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, a budget modification is submitted for review to continue the development of a**
12 **Home Health Agency.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 14 **1. It hereby approves the use of the Program Year 2 budget carry over funds into**
15 **the Program Year 3 budget.**
- 16 **2. It hereby approves the Elder Health Care Initiative, Budget Modification #1 as**
17 **submitted.**
- 18 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice**
19 **Chairman and any designated Official is hereby authorized to negotiate and**
20 **execute contracts associated with this grant and to expend funds when**
21 **received.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH.**
24 **day of FEBRUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,993.7 FOR;**
25 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 171.8[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
26 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
27 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
28 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
29 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


