

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of Funds from the Administration for Native Americans -
Land Use Planning Project)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-044

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is dedicated to the development of improved long**
2 **range planning for land use and development of the Nation's social and economic**
3 **resources for the betterment of the Nation's people and their future; and**
4 **WHEREAS, the Land Use Planning project is the best first step in the process of improving the**
5 **Nation's options for a well planned future; and**
6 **WHEREAS, this opportunity has been brought before the Districts of the Nation for their**
7 **information and approval; and**
8 **WHEREAS, the Districts of the Nation have requested by resolution that the Nation authorize**
9 **the Administration for Native Americans grant proposal for Land Use Planning;**
10 **and**
11 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Native Americans has awarded \$131,901.00 in grant funds**
12 **for the Nation's Land Use Planning project in their 1999 funding cycle; and**
13 **WHEREAS, the Nation, through it's people, it's Chairman and it's Legislative Council**
14 **has mandated a need for land use planning in the people's consensus on and the**
15 **Legislative Council's acceptance and adoption of the Chairman's Administrative**
16 **Plan under Resolution No. 97-082, with regard to land use planning; and**
17 **WHEREAS, the Land Use Planning project will be a one year project that is eligible to extend to**
18 **a two year project; and**
19 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Executive Branch, through the Planning Department shall implement**
20 **this grant project and is authorized to expend these ANA grant funds on behalf of**
21 **the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**
22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council accepts the grant award of**
23 **\$131,901.00 from Administration for Native Americans (ANA) for a SEDS grant to**
24 **assist the Tohono O'odham Nation in the Land Use Planning project, which will be**
25 **a one to two year project implemented by the Executive Branch through the**
26 **Planning Department.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH,**
28 **day of FEBRUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR;**
29 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**


