

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval to fund a Consultant to conduct Assessment for the Detention Facilities)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-046

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation submitted a proposal to the Department of Justice -**
2 **Office of Justice Programs to fund the planning program for the assessment and**
3 **pre design of a Juvenile and Adult Detention Facility; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation's proposal was not awarded funds for FY 2000; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the program assessment needs to be done for the Adult Detention program and a**
6 **revised assessment done for the Juvenile program to apply for Department of**
7 **Justice funding in FY 2001; and**

8 **WHEREAS, it is requested by the technical committee, comprised of Planning, Police**
9 **Department, Judicial, Courts, Attorney General and Adult Detention program staff**
10 **members, to continue on with the needs assessment and planning of the proposed**
11 **facility; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the funding requested to fund this needs assessment and planning phase is**
13 **\$82,800.00.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby approves the requested**
15 **funding of \$82,800.00 to conduct the needed needs assessment and planning phase**
16 **to prepare for the next funding cycle under the DOJ.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby appropriates \$82,800.00 from**
18 **the Nation's IC-007 Account and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to execute**
19 **any contracts or other documents reasonably necessary to accomplish the needs**
20 **assessment and planning phase specified above.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the needed needs assessment and planning phase is to be**
22 **completed no later than ninety (90) days from the date a consultant is selected.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH.**
25 **day of FEBRUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,037.4 FOR;**
26 **-0- AGAINST; 128.1 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
27 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
28 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
29 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
30 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




