1	WHEREAS, representatives of the Tohono O'odham Nation participated in a meeting in
2	Ensenada, Baja California on May 13, 1999 with other Indian tribes, officials of the
3	United States Environmental Protection Agency and SEMARNAP of the federal
4	government of Mexico, and representatives of the ten border states in Mexico and
5	the United States; and
6	WHEREAS, the representatives gathered at this meeting approved a document entitled
7	"Coordination Principles Between the Border XXI National Coordinators and the
8	U.S. and Mexican Border States and U.S. Tribes for the Border XXI Program,"
9	(attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference), whose purpose is to
10	promote broad participation in the Border XXI objective of establishing
11	coordinated environmental management by all governmental entities along the
12	U.S. Mexico border; and
13	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed these Coordination
14	Principles.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports and
16	endorses the Coordination Principles referenced above, and authorizes the
17	Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign the document and to do all other
18	things reasonably necessary to fulfill the Nation's responsibilities under the
19	Border XXI program.
20 21	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>09TH.</u> day of <u>FEBRUARY, 2000</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1.877.4</u> FOR;

23	by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
24	Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
