1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 99-467, the Legislative Council approved a lease of a parcel of the
2		Nation's trust land, comprising approximately 80 acres, located adjacent to
3		Interstate 19 at the Pima Mine Road exit within the San Xavier District, to the
4		Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority for the purpose of locating a gaming facility
5		thereon; and
6	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 93-311, the Legislative Council adopted the Charter of the Tohono
7		O'odham Gaming Authority as the entity of the Nation charged with developing,
8		operating and maintaining the Nation's gaming facilities; and
9	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 99-476, the Legislative Council approved the general
10		development plan and architect's design for the complete development of the
11		entire premises which is subject to the lease approved by Resolution No. 99-467;
12		and
13	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority recommends financing the construction,
14		development and equipment of the new gaming facility to be located on the Pima
15		Mine Road site through a loan from the Bank of America, N.A., (the "Bank"),
16		pursuant to the terms of a business loan agreement (the "Loan Agreement"), a copy
17		of which is appended hereto; and
18	WHEREAS,	under the terms of the proposed Loan Agreement, the Bank would lend the Nation
19		up to \$50,000,000.00, secured by a pledge from the Gaming Authority (evidenced by
20		a Security Agreement executed by the Gaming Authority) of (a) the "Net Gaming
21		Revenues" of the gaming enterprises of the Nation (as defined in and pursuant to
22		the terms of the Loan Agreement), and (b) a security interest in the furniture,
23		gaming and other equipment and other personal property used at the gaming
24		facilities (but not any lien on any lands, premises or buildings owned or controlled
25		by the Nation or the Gaming Authority), as provided in the Loan Agreement; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Authority management board has approved executing a pledge of
27		collateral as security under the Loan Agreement; and

1	WHEREAS,	it is in the interests of the Nation to finance its new gaming facility in accordance
2		with the terms of the proposed Loan Agreement.
3	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
4		1. The proposed financing arrangement between the Nation and the Bank as set
5		forth in the Loan Agreement is hereby approved.
6		2. The Nation's Chairman is authorized and directed to execute a Loan Agreement
7		(substantially in the form appended hereto) on behalf of the Nation, and to
8		execute such other instruments and documents as may be required to give
9		effect to the transactions herein contemplated, and to take such other actions
10		as may hereafter be necessary and appropriate to carry out the obligations of
11		the Nation thereunder.
12		3. The Nation hereby grants a limited waiver of sovereign immunity in favor of the
13		Bank as stated in Section 10.14 of the Loan Agreement (and, in that connection,
14		also hereby modifies, only for the transaction described in the Loan Agreement
15		and Security Agreement, and for no other, the limited waiver of immunity
16		otherwise available under the Charter of the Tohono O'odham Gaming
17		Authority, Section 8, consistent with the terms and conditions of the Loan
18		Agreement and the Security Agreement); the Nation consents to the arbitration
19		provisions of the Loan Agreement, and consents to be sued in a court of
20		competent jurisdiction as specified in the Loan Agreement in connection with
21		the Bank's enforcement of the obligations of the Nation under the Loan
22		Agreement. This waiver and consent is specifically limited as provided in the
23		Loan Agreement and extends to suits (as defined in section 10.14 of the Loan
24		Agreement) against the Nation and its Gaming Authority, officers, agents and
25		attorneys; provided, however, that no officer, agent or attorney of the Nation or
26		its Gaming Authority shall be personally liable for the payment of the loan or for
27		the obligations of the Nation or its Gaming Authority undertaken pursuant to

the Loan Agreement or the Security Agreement.
