RESOLUTION NO. 2000-062

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Higher Education Services have been**
2 **successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services has a FY-1994 savings in the amount of \$137,963.40**
4 **as identified by the Grants & Contracts Office.**
5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**
6 **Higher Education Services budget modification #1 reflecting the FY-1994 savings**
7 **in the amount of \$137,963.40 with a total modification in the amount of**
8 **\$859,476.38.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH,**
10 **day of FEBRUARY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR;**
11 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
12 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
13 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
14 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
15 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
