

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriate \$100,000.00 from the Investment Account IC-007 to Purchase a Modular Building to House the Tohono O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-076

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognized that all citizens regardless of**
2 **disability have dignity and a right to work and participate in society; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the O'odham Education**
4 **Department's Vocational Rehabilitation Program to provide quality culturally**
5 **appropriate vocational rehabilitation services to eligible tribal members and**
6 **other American Indians with disabilities who reside on or near the Tohono**
7 **O'odham Nation to prepare for, enter into, gain or retain employment; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a Section 121 grant by the U.S.**
9 **Department of Education, Rehabilitation Service Administration to cover 90% of**
10 **the total operating costs to establish and operate the Tohono O'odham Vocational**
11 **Rehabilitation Program; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the approved grant proposal's narrative states, *The Nation will provide office space***
13 ***for each of the Vocational Rehabilitation Program staff and a space for informal***
14 ***gatherings to be used by consumers. Office furnishings, telephones, utilities and***
15 ***janitorial services will also be provided. These facilities and services will be***
16 ***included as part of our 10% match for funding. All facilities will meet ADA***
17 ***requirements and OSHA requirements; and***

18 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office met with the Investment Committee and they identified**
19 **\$100,000.00 from the Investment Account IC-007 to purchase a modular building**
20 **for the Tohono O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
22 **appropriates funds from the Investment Account IC-007 in the amount of**
23 **\$100,000.00 to purchase a Modular office building for the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Vocational Rehabilitation Program to successfully implement quality culturally**
25 **appropriate, vocational rehabilitation services to qualified tribal members and**
26 **other American Indians with disabilities.**


