(Approving a Design/Build Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority and Design Build Alliance, Inc. for the Construction of a new Gaming Facility)

1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 93-311, the Legislative Council adopted the Charter of the Tohono				
2		O'odham Gaming Authority as the entity of the Nation charged with developing,				
3		operating and maintaining the Nation's gaming facilities; and				
4	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 99-467, the Legislative Council approved a lease (the "Lease") of a				
5		parcel of the Nation's trust land, comprising approximately 80 acres, located				
6		adjacent to Interstate 19 at the Pima Mine Road exit within the San Xavier District,				
7		to the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority for the purpose of locating a gaming				
8		facility thereon; and				
9	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 99-476, the Legislative Council approved the general development				
10		plan and architect's design for the complete development of the entire premises (the				
11		"Gaming Facility"), which is subject to the Lease approved by Resolution No. 99-467;				
12		and				
13	WHEREAS,	in accordance with Section 6 of the Lease, the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority				
14	}	recommends constructing the Gaming Facility through a design/build contract,				
15		substantially in the form attached hereto, with Design Build Alliance, Inc. (the				
16		"Design/Builder"), a licensed and bonded construction contractor, in which the				
17		Design/Builder will assume all risk and all liability for, and guarantee completion				
18		of, the Gaming Facility and the payment in full of claims of all persons for work				
19		performed in or materials furnished for construction of the Gaming Facility; and				
20	WHEREAS,	it is in the interests of the Nation for the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority to				
21		construct the Gaming Facility under the terms of the proposed Design/Build				
22		Agreement with the Design/Builder; and				
23	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee recommends approval of the proposed Design/Build				
24		Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority and Design Build				
25		Alliance, Inc. for the construction of the new Gaming Facility.				
26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:					
27		1. The Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority's proposal to satisfy the provisions of				
28		Section 6 of the Lease through a design/build arrangement in which the

Design/Builder, a licensed and bonded construction contractor, assumes all risk and all liability for, and guarantees completion of, the Gaming Facility and the payment in full of claims of all persons for work performed in or materials furnished for construction of the Gaming Facility is hereby approved.

- 2. The proposed Design/Build Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, between the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority and Design Build Alliance, Inc. for the construction of the new Gaming Facility is hereby approved.
- 3. In accordance with the terms of the proposed agreement, the Nation hereby grants a limited waiver of sovereign immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority in favor of the Design/Builder, on the following terms:
- (a) The Nation waives any immunity from suit or action the Gaming Authority enjoys with respect to any and all controversies, claims, or disputes (collectively, "Disputes"), claims, counterclaims, and/or crossclaims brought by the Design/Builder under, arising out of, or related to the Design/Build Agreement;
- (b) The Nation consents to an arbitration against the Gaming Authority before the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") in accordance with the provisions of Article 10 of the Design/Build Agreement upon any and all Disputes, claims, counterclaims, and/or crossclaims brought by the Design/Builder under, arising out of, or related to the Design/Build Agreement and to a suit, action, or proceeding in any court of competent jurisdiction (in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 10.3 of the Design/Build Agreement) to confirm an arbitration award, to have judgment entered, and to execute upon any such judgment against the personalty of the Gaming Authority, whether located on or off the Nation's lands; and
- (c) The Nation waives any obligation the Design/Builder otherwise might have to exhaust tribal remedies before pursuing arbitration, obtaining a judgment confirming an arbitration award, and/or executing on a judgment confirming an arbitration award.

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Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Nation's limited waiver of the Gaming Authority's sovereign immunity with respect to the execution on any arbitration award, judgment, or order only extends to the sums owed by the Gaming Authority to the Design/Builder under the terms of the Design/Build Agreement (including any liquidated damages payable because of a termination of the Design/Build Agreement), plus attorneys' fees and other costs and any interest accrued or accruing on those sums. The waiver extends to the Gaming Authority's officers, directors, members, agents, and attorneys, but no officer, director, member, agent, or attorney of or for the Gaming Authority shall have any personal liability for any of the Gaming Authority's obligations under the Design/Build Agreement or under any arbitration award, judgment, or order. Moreover, the limited waiver of sovereign immunity applies only for the transaction described in the Design/Build Agreement and for no other. The Nation also hereby modifies (for the transaction described in the Design/Build Agreement and for no other) the limited waiver of immunity otherwise available under the Charter of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority, Section 8, consistent with the foregoing.

- 4. Also in accordance with the terms of the proposed agreement, the Nation hereby grants a limited waiver of sovereign immunity in favor of the Design/Builder, but that this waiver shall be effective only if (i) the Legislative Council dissolves the Gaming Authority or (ii) the Gaming Authority assigns the Design/Build Agreement to the Nation. The terms of this limited waiver of sovereign immunity are as follows:
- (a) The Nation waives any immunity from suit or action the Nation enjoys with respect to any and all controversies, claims, or disputes (collectively, "Disputes"), claims, counterclaims, and/or crossclaims brought by the Design/Builder under, arising out of, or related to the Design/Build Agreement;
- (b) The Nation consents to an arbitration against the Nation before the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") in accordance with the provisions of Article 10 of the Design/Build Agreement upon any and all Disputes, claims, counterclaims,

and/or crossclaims brought by the Design/Builder under, arising out of, or related to the Design/Build Agreement and to a suit, action, or proceeding in any court of competent jurisdiction (in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 10.3 of the Design/Build Agreement) to confirm an arbitration award, to have judgment entered, and to execute upon any such judgment against the personalty of the Nation, whether located on or off the Nation's lands; and

(c) The Nation waives any obligation the Design/Builder otherwise might have to exhaust tribal remedies before pursuing arbitration, obtaining a judgment confirming an arbitration award, and/or executing on a judgment confirming an arbitration award.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Nation's limited waiver of its sovereign immunity with respect to the execution on any arbitration award, judgment, or order only extends to the sums owed by the Gaming Authority or the Nation to the Design/Builder under the terms of the Design/Build Agreement (including any liquidated damages payable because of a termination of the Design/Build Agreement), plus attorneys' fees and other costs and any interest accrued or accruing on those sums. The waiver extends to the Nation's officers, directors, members, agents, and attorneys, but no officer, director, member, agent, or attorney of or for the Nation shall have any personal liability for any of the Gaming Authority's or the Nation's obligations under the Design/Build Agreement or under any arbitration award, judgment, or order. Moreover, the limited waiver of sovereign immunity applies only for the transaction described in the Design/Build Agreement and for no other.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>28TH</u>, day of <u>FEBRUARY</u>, <u>2000</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,595.35</u> FOR; <u>506.1</u> AGAINST; <u>64.05</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>[03]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(5) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
