**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-087**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the importance of cultural history and the**  
2 **protection of cultural resource sites; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has passed an Archaeological Resources Protection**  
4 **Ordinance (Resolution No. 06-84) and has established a Cultural Affairs Program to**  
5 **help protect and preserve cultural sites; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided support for a Cultural Center/Museum**  
7 **Committee to plan and design a cultural center/museum for the Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the preservation of traditional knowledge,**  
9 **cultural history, language and education programs and O'odham himdag; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation appreciates the invitation of the Smithsonian**  
11 **Institution's National Museum of the American Indian to be one of first twelve tribes**  
12 **selected to participate in the "OUR PEOPLES" exhibit which will highlight the opening**  
13 **of the National Museum of the American Indian in 2002.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the**  
15 **invitation of the Smithsonian Institution's National Museum of the American Indian**  
16 **to participate in the "OUR PEOPLES" exhibit which will highlight the opening of the**  
17 **National Museum of the American Indian in 2002.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appoints the following**  
19 **committee of four to represent the Tohono O'odham Nation and work with the staff**  
20 **of the National Museum of the American Indian to design and create the Tohono**  
21 **O'odham Nation exhibit as part of the larger "OUR PEOPLES" exhibit.**

6 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
7 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


