

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part H FY 2000)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-093

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Master Contract with the Secretary**
2 **of Interior for the purpose of performing certain services, functions, programs**
3 **and/or activities which are funded throughout the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the**
4 **benefit of Indians; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby exercises her right to prepare a budget for FY**
6 **2000, in the amount of \$17,873.85.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby finds**
8 **that it is in the best interest of the Nation to continue to contract the activities,**
9 **functions, services and/or programs identified in the Annual Funding Agreement for**
10 **Fiscal Year 2000.**

11 **1. The Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation is authorized to negotiate and**
12 **execute the Annual Funding Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and**
13 **the Secretary of Interior for all services, functions, activities and/or programs as**
14 **described in the Master Contract at Article 1, subsection 2, Purpose, and the**
15 **Annual Funding Agreement for the 2000 fiscal year.**

16 **2. In the event that Congress does not appropriate any and/or sufficient funds**
17 **commonly known as "Contract Support Funds" for those contracted services,**
18 **functions, activities and/or programs contained in the Annual Funding Agreement**
19 **which would otherwise be eligible for such Contract Support funds then:**


20 **a. The Chairman of the Nation shall notify the Secretary of the Department of the**
21 **Interior that the Nation retrocedes, effective at midnight on September 30,**
22 **2000 all programs, services, functions and/or activities contained in the**
23 **Annual Funding Agreement which are eligible for "Contract Support Funds."**

24 **b. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to pursue any and all legal remedy,**
25 **which may be available to recoup "Contract Support Funds."**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH, day**
27 **of MARCH, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
