

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Tohono O'odham Youth Services FY 2000 Close Up Program)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-094**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono O'odham Youth**  
2 **Services (T.O.Y.S.) Program who has been awarded a Close Up State and Local**  
3 **Program Grant for 1999/2000; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the awarded amount to the T.O.Y.S. Program is in the amount of \$1,500.00 to develop**  
5 **a local Close Up Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the purpose of the Close Up Program is to educate, increase awareness to the youth**  
7 **in the Public and B.I.A. schools where the Nation's youth attend school on Tribal**  
8 **Government and Operations of the Tri-Branches: Executive Branch, Legislative**  
9 **Branch and Judicial Branch. Students will increase their knowledge as dual citizens**  
10 **of the U.S. and of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services submitted a proposal budget to the Tohono**  
12 **O'odham Nation Legislative Council for acceptance and expenditure of the FY 2000**  
13 **Close Up Program in the amount of \$1,500.00; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports and approves the acceptance and**  
15 **expenditure of the Tohono O'odham Youth Services, FY 2000 Close Up Program**  
16 **Budget.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
18 **O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated officials are**  
19 **hereby authorized to execute and expend the grant award.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH, day**  
21 **of MARCH, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**  
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
24 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


