

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Addressing Coleman Road)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-097

1 **WHEREAS, Coleman Road is a trespass upon the lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
2 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council, the Community of San Pedro and the Community**
3 **of Pan Tak have requested that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council address the**
4 **matter of Coleman Road.**
5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Office of Attorney General of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation shall take such actions as are consistent with the discussion pertaining to the**
7 **matter of the Coleman Road trespass had this date in a closed session of the Tohono**
8 **O'odham Legislative Council, including, but not limited to, seeking legal and**
9 **equitable relief.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH. day**
11 **of MARCH, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
12 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
13 **Section 2 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
14 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
15 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
16 **Stat. 984).**




