

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval and Acceptance of the Application for the Air Quality Assessment Project Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-100

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the environment**
2 **and safe guarding the health and well being of the Nation's members; and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation sets out the**
4 **Council's continuing responsibility to assure for all members safe and healthful**
5 **surroundings; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, in the past and present, air quality issues have threatened the environment, health**
7 **and well-being, and the sovereignty of the Nation; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has reserved**
9 **\$144,363.00 of Clean Air Act grant funding to support an Air Quality Assessment**
10 **Project for the Nation; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Environmental Office has prepared an application package for these**
12 **funds; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the Project would allow the Nation to conduct a Source Inventory, Air Emissions**
14 **Inventory, and a Monitoring Plan, with the goal of establishing an air quality code**
15 **for the Nation.**
- 16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
17 **approves the Tohono O'odham Nation Air Quality Assessment Project grant**
18 **application to the USEPA.**
- 19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council accepts the grant funding that EPA has reserved for**
20 **the Tohono O'odham Nation.**
- 21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the**
22 **expenditure of funds according to this budget, which shall be in effect from February**
23 **14, 2000 to September 30, 2001.**
- 24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono**
25 **O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated**
26 **official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,**
27 **that any amendments affecting the funding for funding levels of the grant shall be**
28 **submitted for further prior approval.**



7 Stat. 984).


