

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2000 National Indian Council on Aging, Inc. (NICOA) Elderly Work Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-122

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has recognized the need to include all the NICOA**
2 **workers in awarding a Christmas bonus to each working elder; and**
3 **WHEREAS, historically elders participating in the NICOA work program have received their**
4 **Christmas Bonus; and**
5 **WHEREAS, in addition, an Annual Christmas Bonus should be established for the elderly**
6 **workers in recognition of their hard work and contribution to the Nation's Senior**
7 **Services Program; and**
8 **WHEREAS, a budget has been submitted requesting for funds to provide each NICOA worker a**
9 **\$500.00 Christmas Bonus.**
10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
11 **approves the budget in the amount of \$8,500.00 to support the Christmas Bonus and**
12 **is authorized to be expended accordingly.**
13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of \$8,500.00 be appropriated from FY 98 identified**
14 **savings.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. day**
16 **of MARCH, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,426.6 FOR; 738.9**
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
18 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
19 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
20 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
21 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
