

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2000 Elder Conference)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-123

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has identified a need to hold a conference for the Elders**
2 **of the Nation, that is uniquely tailored to meet their needs; and**

3 **WHEREAS, historically Elders attended conferences abroad, however, the infirm and frail were**
4 **unable to attend conferences due to the distance and to their immobility and that by**
5 **conducting a conference within the boundaries of the Nation it will address this**
6 **barrier and encompass a greater number of Elders; and**

7 **WHEREAS, in addition, many do not fully understand the English language as O'odham is their**
8 **primary language and that by tailoring this conference to meet their needs, in that**
9 **the conference will be conducted within the Nation's boundaries.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
11 **the budget in the amount of \$100,000.00, to be appropriated from the IC007 Account,**
12 **to support the Annual Elder's Conference and is authorized to be expended**
13 **accordingly.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby requests that the Chairman of the**
15 **Nation include the Annual Elder's Conference budget in the Executive Branch FY**
16 **2001 Base Budgets proposals, and annually thereafter.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day**
18 **of MARCH, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,007.4 FOR; -0-**
19 **AGAINST; 156.8 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
20 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
21 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
22 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
23 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




