5		conducting a conference within the boundaries of the Nation it will address this							
6		barrier and encompass a greater number of Elders; and							
7	WHEREAS,	in addition, many do not fully understand the English language as O'odham is their							
8		primary language and that by tailoring this conference to meet their needs, in that							
9		the conference will be conducted within the Nation's boundaries.							
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves								
11		the budget in the amount of \$100,000.00, to be appropriated from the IC007 Account,							
12		to support the Annual Elder's Conference and is authorized to be expended							
13		accordingly.							
14	BE IT FURTI	SOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby requests that the Chairman of the							
15		Nation include the Annual Elder's Conference budget in the Executive Branch FY							
16		2001 Base Budgets proposals, and annually thereafter.
