

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the San Xavier Cooperative Association Request to Fund Farm Operations,**  
**Farm, Farm Rehabilitation Planning and Other Projects)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-126

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation provided funding to the San Xavier Cooperative  
2 Association (SXCA) in May 1998 for the Alfalfa and Mesquite Projects and for  
3 Equipment Purchase and Well Rehabilitation, from the Southern Arizona Water  
4 Rights Settlement Act of 1982 (SAWRSA) Trust of the Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, the SXCA has completed the majority of the work under this funding; and

6 WHEREAS, SAWRSA, mandates that a delivery and distribution system be constructed for the  
7 SXCA Farm for the delivery of Central Arizona Project (CAP) water; and

8 WHEREAS, the CAP Link Pipeline, which will bring CAP water to the farm, is in the beginning  
9 stages of construction and is scheduled for completion in January 2001; and

10 WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain the current operations at the SXCA Farm to prepare for  
11 eventual delivery of the CAP water to the Farm and to prepare for the rehabilitation  
12 of the farm and the farming business; and

13 WHEREAS, the SXCA has submitted a proposal for funding to accomplish the above-mentioned  
14 needs; and

15 WHEREAS, the funding request components and costs are as follows:

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
26 approves the funding request by the San Xavier Cooperative Association, in the  
27 amount of \$1 million, for farm operations, farm rehabilitation planning, facilities,  
28 bale building demonstration and traditional garden projects, from the SAWRSA  
29 Trust Fund.

30 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day  
31 of MARCH, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,341.3 FOR; 666.1  
32 AGAINST; 158.1 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
33 Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
34 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
35 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
36 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


