

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(In Support of the Tohono O'odham Education Department's FY 2001 Appropriations Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-133**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is charged with the responsibility of**  
2 **supporting programs and or departments and entities that benefit all Tohono**  
3 **O'odham; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services and the Employment Assistance Program historically**  
5 **have been lacking their own support staff (i.e. a secretary or office support worker);**  
6 **and**

7 **WHEREAS, a total of one hundred eleven (111) students are currently receiving services under**  
8 **the programs, fifty (50) under Higher Education and sixty-one (61) under**  
9 **Employment Assistance Program services, justifying the need of support staff; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the hiring of support staff will allow both program coordinators to focus more on the**  
11 **recruitment, retention and completion of Vocational and Academic programs of**  
12 **their students; and**

13 **WHEREAS, historically the Employment Assistance program has experienced running out of**  
14 **funding before the end of the fiscal year thereby causing student applications to be**  
15 **put on hold until funding is available; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services is anticipating running out of funds before this**  
17 **current fiscal year FY 2000 ends; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Career Center has currently outgrown its present facilities**  
19 **thereby requesting a 10,000 square feet multi-purpose building to support eight**  
20 **apprenticeable programs as well as a GED program.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council fully supports**  
22 **the Tohono O'odham Education Departments FY 2001 appropriations request in the**  
23 **total amount of \$1,618,019.90, broken down as follows: Higher Education at**  
24 **\$515,861.94, Employment Assistance Program at \$348,678.00, and Career Center at**  
25 **\$753,480.00.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21<sup>ST</sup> day**  
27 **of MARCH, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**  
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


